

10 STEPS TO READY FOR CONSTRUCTION

1. Decide where the dumpster will be placed and where trucks can park each day.
2. Decide which entrance subcontractors can enter/exit through and put a lockbox on this door for easy access.
3. Decide on a restroom for the subcontractors to have access to during the day (or rent a port-a-potty).
4. Locate an appropriate place for subcontractors to set-up saws and tools each day
5. Pick a place for construction materials to be stored throughout the project.



Although renovating can be messy, the end result is worth it!

6. Plastic sheets and zipper walls can prevent dust from traveling to the rest of your home. Drop cloths or ramboard will protect floors.
7. Note existing conditions of the area.
8. For kitchen renovations, set up a temporary kitchen with microwave, coffee maker, hot plate, etc.
9. Always maintain open communication with your project manager, addressing issues as soon as they come up.
10. Visualize the end result and try not to focus too much on the mess and chaos of the remodeling process.
