Bob Schneider is the Technical Director of the Defense Information Systems Agency (DISA) Defense Spectrum Organization (DSO). He is responsible for providing technical oversight and advice across the DSO including spectrum strategy development, spectrum technology roadmap development, outreach to DoD Labs, and DSO technical capabilities. His prior assignment was as Chief of the DSO Spectrum Enterprise Systems Division where he was responsible for spectrum tools, services, GEMSIS, supporting databases, and emerging spectrum technologies research. He has served the DSO for 28 years, primarily within the Joint Spectrum Center (JSC) Division, having completed a wide variety of assignments and projects supporting virtually all of the organization's mission areas. Prior to joining the DSO, Bob served the Illinois Institute of Technology Research Institute (IITRI) for ten years, providing technical and project management support for the DoD on various spectrum issues.
